## The Harold Company Performers “The Show Must Go On” Scholarship

The Board of Directors of The Harold Company Performers, a nonprofit theater company named in memory of beloved Whitley County educator and musical director, Harold Norman, created this scholarship in 2025 as a way to honor seniors at Churubusco and Columbia City High Schools. The Harold Company Performers has an overarching goal of offering high-quality, live theatrical productions to Whitley County with affordable access for audiences and is largely composed of talent connected to these school districts, whose high school experiences flourished because of their engagement with the arts. The ideal recipient of this scholarship from each school will have been actively involved with the respective institution’s fine arts programs. Applicants should include a resume complete with extracurricular, community, and work experience, an unofficial transcript, a 100 word purpose statement regarding his or her future career plans, and a 1-2 minute video of choice. Applicants do not need to pursue a career in the arts, as many past and current members of The Harold Company Performers have careers in education, business, engineering, and law, just to name a few. This is a one-time, non-renewable, \$500 scholarship.

### Overview

- Application deadline: April 1, 2026
- Attend a 2 year accredited training program or 4 year accredited college or university
- CHS and CCHS senior of the current year
- GPA reflective of a respectful academic commitment
- Active participation in the fine arts program
- Full enrollment in high school classes the final semester of his or her senior year
- Need not be majoring in Fine Arts
- One-time, non-renewable, \$500

  - 100 word career purpose statement
  - 1-2 minute video which showcases your talent
